



Tie Down Methods For Store-Safe Containers And Dangerous Goods Stores

In situations when twist locks are not present, empty containers can be fastened down with chains as per National Transport Commission [Load Restraint Guide](#), utilising the lifting eyes in the corners of the containers.

The container must be positioned on timber dunnage, a timber deck, friction matting or rubber pads.

It is unsafe to place containers on coaming rails or metal loading decks.

When restraining empty containers that weight 2.7 tonnes or below, transport chains should be a minimum of 8 millimetres in diameter. They should be tensioned with dogs or turnbuckles to a minimum of 1000 kilograms.
